Additional information for completing the Concession Area/Café checklist:


Menus – For individuals who are blind or have low vision, restaurants should offer menus in an alternative format, such as Braille or large print. If this is not feasible, restaurants should train staff on how to assist customers who are blind or have low vision.

At least 5% of all fixed seating or tables provided shall be accessible by a route at least 36" wide from the entrance and also have an access route to the restroom facilities. Where it is practical, accessible tables should be distributed throughout the space or facility.

If seating spaces for people who use wheelchairs are provided at tables or counters, 60" of clear floor space shall be provided.

The tops of tables should be between 28" and 34" high from the floor or ground.

Food service lines shall have a minimum clear width of 36", with a preferred clear width of 42" where passage of stopped wheelchairs by pedestrians is desired. Tray slides shall be mounted no higher than 34" above the floor.
