Sauna and Steam Room Checklist Information


Definitions for saunas and steam rooms:

- Sauna is a small room designed to be heated to very high temperatures, with well-controlled humidity. Saunas are used both for recreational and therapeutic purposes, with most people utilizing them as a relaxation tool that provides additional health benefits.
- Steam room is an enclosed space with large amounts of high temperature steam, creating a high humidity environment. People sit in this room in a similar way to a sauna (conversely a hot, but dry atmosphere), for relaxation and purported benefits to health and well being.

Additional information for completing the Sauna/Steam Room checklist:

If saunas or steam rooms are in a cluster, at least 5 percent, but not less than one of each type must be accessible. If seating is provided, at least one bench must be accessible. Doors cannot swing into any part of the clear floor or ground space required for benches.

Back Support: The bench shall provide for back support or shall be affixed to a wall. Back support shall be 42 inches long minimum and shall extend from a point 2 inches maximum above the seat surface to a point 18 inches minimum above the seat surface. Back support shall be 2 1/2 inches maximum from the rear edge of the seat measured horizontally.
