Spa/Hot Tub Checklist Information

Definitions for Spas and Hot Tubs:

- **Pool lift** is a piece of equipment which transfers a person directly into the water.
- Transfer wall allows a person to transfer from a wheelchair to a raised wall surrounding the spa or hot tub. The depth (how wide the wall is) of the transfer wall must be 12 inches minimum and 16 inches maximum.
- Transfer systems include raised platforms or stairs that allow a person to transfer to the stairs or platform to enter and exit the water.

Additional information for completing Spa/Hot Tub checklist:

Accessible means of entry/exit are required for spas and hot tubs. Spas must provide a pool lift, transfer wall, or transfer system.

EXCEPTION: Where spas are provided in a cluster, no more than 5 percent, but no fewer than one spa in each cluster shall be required to comply.
